Anishnawbe Health Foundation raises vital funds in support of Anishnawbe Health Toronto, a fully accredited Community Health Centre that improves the health and well-being of First Nations, Inuit and Métis people in spirit, mind, emotion and body by providing traditional healing within a multi-disciplinary health care model.

The Foundation is seeking community-minded individuals who are willing to devote their time, energy and talent to making an impact on the health and well-being of the Indigenous community by serving on its Finance, Audit and Investment Committee.

The Finance and Investment Committee is responsible for determining the financial needs of the Foundation and ensuring that the needs will be met by expected cash flows. It also recommends policies, budgets and considers all financial matters for the Board of Directors and oversees the Foundation's annual audit.

Specific Areas of Expertise needed:

We recruit our Committee members based on the experience and capabilities of each member and in consideration of specific skill sets required by the Board. Currently, we are seeking Committee members who have expertise in the following areas:

- Accounting, preferably a member with a Chartered Accountant designation
- Finance
- Audit
- Legal expertise, particularly corporate and not-for profit law

Primary or Secondary experience in fundraising, particularly experience with capital campaigns and major gifts fundraising from individuals, corporations and foundations, is an asset. Committee members should be individuals who are willing to devote the time and energy necessary to perform the role. This includes time for committee meetings and orientation. It also includes individuals who understand the need to avoid any conflicts of interest and to act with a standard of care to steward the assets of a charitable organization. Knowledge of the urban Indigenous community and passion about healthcare and Traditional Healing practices are an asset.

Time Commitment and Governance Structure of the Foundation:

The Finance, Audit and Investment Committee is a standing committee of the Foundation's Board of Directors and is chaired by the Foundation's Treasurer. Committee meetings are quarterly. Participation in meetings by teleconference is available. Committee members are appointed, by the Foundation's Board of Directors, for three-year terms, with the possibility to serve up to three
